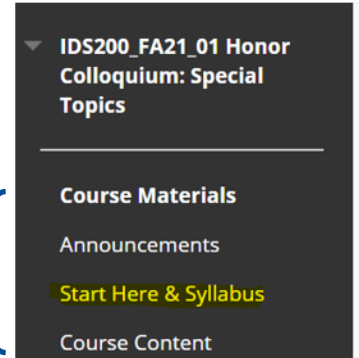


# Student Guide: How to Navigate Your Blackboard Course

**STEP 1: Once you're logged into your course, look for and read any or all of the following:**

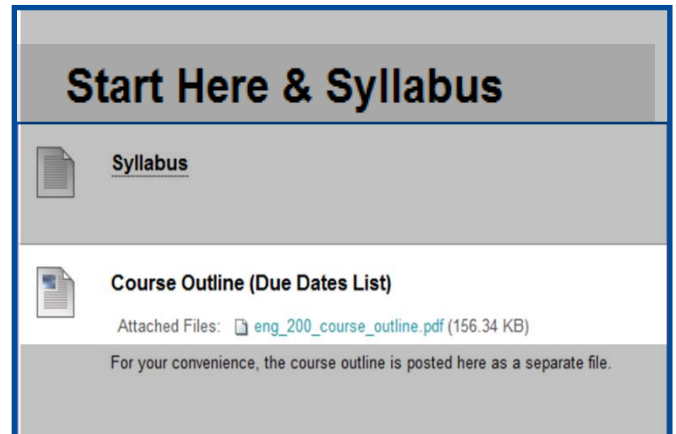
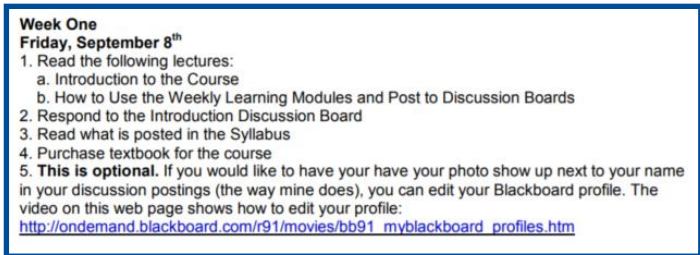
- a. Welcome or Week One Assignments announcement
- b. Information inside the *Start Here & Syllabus* content area (or a similar content area), including the syllabus
- c. Welcome email from the Instructor (check *your student email*) or course message from the instructor (check *Course Messages in Bb* in *Blackboard*)



Use the course navigation menu on the left side of the screen to access course content.

**STEP 2: Look for the course outline or due dates list in the syllabus or in the “Start Here & Syllabus” content area (or a similar content area).**

- a. Print or download and save a copy of the course outline or due dates. (The image on the right is an example of where you might find this information.)
- b. Follow the directions of what to work on. (See example of directions below.)



**STEP 3: Find assignments and read the directions.**

- a. On the course navigation menu, look for an assignments content area or specific assignment tools, such as *Discussions*, *Quizzes*, *Journals*, *Assignments*, etc.
- b. Assignments also may be inside the *Course Content* or other content area, so be sure to look inside these areas of the course. (The example to the right shows an assignment link in the Course Content Module 1 folder.)
