



Objectives:

1. To attract qualified students to Quinsigamond Community College and UMass Dartmouth.
2. To promote and facilitate an efficient transition of transfer students between institutions.
3. To provide specific information and guidelines for transfer students.
4. To encourage academic coordination and cooperation, including curricular reviews, on-site visits, and joint academic advising for students attending Quinsigamond Community College.

Stipulations:

1. UMass Dartmouth guarantees acceptance of Quinsigamond Community College students who complete the Business Administration-Career Degree Program with an overall GPA of 2.5, or higher as outlined in this document.
2. Transfer students designated above will not be required to take more than 68 additional credits to receive a baccalaureate degree.

Mutual Responsibilities:

1. Both institutions agree to maintain current listings of the course equivalencies. This will be the responsibility of the two designated representatives.
2. Quinsigamond Community College and UMass Dartmouth will incorporate a summary of this agreement into official publications and web sites.
3. Quinsigamond Community College and UMass Dartmouth agree to encourage qualified students to participate in this program by providing information, advising and other assistance required to foster a seamless transition from the two-year institution to the four-year institution.

Review/Revision:

1. Both institutions will periodically review this agreement. Substantive changes in the courses or program of either institution will require a review of this articulation agreement. Revisions will be implemented with one year notice prior to termination of the agreement.
