

Articulation Agreement  
Quinsigamond Community College and Regis College

1. The purpose of this Agreement is to foster a spirit of cooperation between these two educational institutions. This Agreement will facilitate the application to, admission to, and completion of the Medical Imaging Bachelor of Science completion program/ major at Regis College. This includes the BS Completion Degree, or any of the following full-time concentrations in Medical Imaging:
  - a. Breast Imaging
  - b. Interventional Radiology
  - c. Nuclear Medicine
2. Regarding the RCRM program, qualified QCC students are eligible for:
  - a. Preferred Admission – there is no limit on the number of students admitted as long as they meet the requirements set forth in this agreement.
  - b. Students will receive academic credit for all college-level courses taken at QCC which will be applied toward the requirements of the Regis Bachelor's degree. In order for courses to be transferred into Regis, a "C" or better must be obtained. (Regis College has sole discretion in determining which college-level QCC courses qualify for credit toward a Regis College Bachelor's degree).
3. To be eligible for the benefits of this agreement, QCC students must:
  - a. Have successfully completed all of the requirements for the associated degree in Radiologic Technology at QCC;
  - b. Have an overall GPA of 2.5;
  - c. Be registry eligible by the ARRT;
  - d. Adhere to all Regis application deadlines and required application materials.
4. The student must take at least 30 credits at Regis College to meet the Regis residency requirement and the curriculum outlined in the Appendix for the various concentrations within the Medical Imaging Bachelor of Science degree.
5. This agreement will be reviewed at least every two years and may be revised by written mutual consent.
6. The agreement may be terminated by either party with not less than one academic semester's notice.
